Statement 103 (7/00) (translation)

For and on behalf of the National League for Democracy its Chairman U Aung Shwe and General Secretary Daw Aung San Suu Kyi have served notice of claim for damages and compensation against the State Peace and Development Council previously known as the State Law and Order Restoration Council (SPDC/SLORC) as required under the Civil Procedure Code Section 80. It was served on the Chairman of the SPDC on the 4th July 2000. The claim is based on the suffering and distress caused by their failure to abide by the provisions of the Pyithu Hluttaw Elections Law which they themselves promulgated and breach of promises made by them.

Similarly, on the same day, notice under Section 80 Civil Procedure Code was served on the State Peace and Development Council's Chairman (for and on behalf of the SPDC) and the Chairman of the Multiparty Party Elections Commission (for and on behalf of the Commission) to halt their acts of aggression, persecution and harassment against the National League for Democracy.
