The Karen Refugee committee believes that many are now keeping awareness that different stories or rumors are spreading about the camps as a result of diverse ethnics, religion and culture are significantly increasing in Refugee community. The SPDC's ruling and political system are vital keys that force the peoples including diverse ethnics to seek refuge in neighboring country.

The Royal Thai Government, since 1995, reduced the number of scattering camps along the Thai-Burma boarder which under the management of the Karen Refugee Committee and combined it to seven camps which recognize it as a Temporary shelter places later. Since then, 95% of the camp populations are ethnic Karen. However, the other ethnic groups are critically increasing after year 2005. Among the seven camps, ethnic group arrived mainly to the three camps in Tak province due to nearness and close to the main road, for easier transport and communication. Mae La camp, located in Tak Son Yang Township has the most population of diverse ethnic groups comprise of Karen, Muslim, Kachin, Chin, Mon, Lahu, Karenni, Lisu, Zomi, Arakan, Thai-yai (Yo doh), Burmese/Chinese, Naga and Burman, in the camp. The ethnic groups, as being arrived after 2005, have not yet registered by the MOI up to present-day, and as a result, they could not participated in any camp management, but some of them under favorable circumstances are allowed to serve the community in substitution of vacant staff who had left for the Third countries. Though not every situation that has taken place is inline with policy of management, but we have to accept their participation due to the demand of circumstances. KRC also make known it to the camp that new arrival should be included in camp advisory committee and as result the following person are elected as the camp advisory committee in Maela camp. They are –

(1) Man Ba Tum (Karen) (2) Rev Simon (Karen) (3) Th'ra Jones (Karen) (4) U Kamal (Muslim) (5) Zao Doi (Kachin).

In previous monthly Report, It was stated that a coordinating committee for Ethnic Group was formed in Mae La camp and the goal is to support and cooperate in ethnic related social affair. Members of the committee are:-

(1) U Harry Tun- Lisu, (2) U Zao Doi- Kachin, (3) Naing Thaung Myint- Mon, (4) Saw Win- Shan, (5) Kaing Myo Tun- Araken.

KRC would like to say that, the incident is contradicts to what most people think that the Karen is discriminating their fellow ethnic is not true. KRC expect not only the cooperation of ethnic in Mae La camp but also the cooperation of ethnic groups in other camp as well.

Maela camp is like “Mini Union of Burma” which have diverse ethnic, cultures, religious opinion, point of views complain, dissatisfy which are undeniable. The Karen Refugee committee always opens the door to any of your worry and fear that you have heard of the camps.

According to the up date information of Mae La camp, the number of unregister people since 2006 up to present are 21,118 in total. The percentage of ethnic population in the

camp are: Karen 75.72%, Burmese 5.50%, Kachin 2.25%, Mon 1.53% Shan 0.72%, Araken 0.63%, Chin 0.50%, Karennie 0.25%, Thai-Karen 0.08%, Bur/Chinese 0.07%, Others 12.75% Religion: Buddish 42.97%, Christian 38.88%, Islam 17.68%, Animist 0.11%, Others 0.36%. 54.48% of the population are Males and 45.52% are Females.

The Karen Refugee committee always keeps awareness and gives suggestion to the camp committee to be careful in dealing with the affair of diverse ethnic living in the camps, and closely works with camp commander for the smoothness of camp Management and in solving any problem existed.

There are some Natural disasters that happened during this year in some of the camps. On 22/3/2010, 60 houses, in Karenni Camp site (1) were ablaze which left 260 persons homeless, and the lost will cost 21 million Baths, estimated by Thai authority. On 29/3/2010, a strong wind swift through Ban Don Yang camp which 58 houses were destroyed and left 237 homeless. KRC, CC and NGOs concern are collaborated immediately for the relief.

The survival of both KRC and KnRC who are responsible for nine camps totally rely on the support of funders and good will of the host country. We admit that we are not perfect in doing all the work we ought to do unless working together with NGOs, CBOs, INGOs and as well with Thai authorities.

March– 2010

- 3/3/10 – KRC’s health coordinator attended a meeting at Backpack office, during the meeting birth certificate issue for IDP children was discussed.
- 5/3/10 – KRC’s Livelihood coordinator attended CDCB Meeting at ZOA office. Reviewing vocational training financial system, Registration, subsidies policies and discussed on future plan.
- 8/3/10 – KRC’s Livelihood coordinator and ZOA livelihood project manager held a meeting at KRC’s office and discussed to form livelihood committee in all the camps. At the same time the team explained the plans/activities and structure of

livelihood committee for the camps, and set to form the committee on 3rd, 10th 11th and 16th March, in Umphiem, Mae La, Nu Po and Mae La Oo, respectively.

- 22-26/3/10 – CMSP (Mae Sot) and TBBC capacity Building officer jointly went to Htam Hin and Ban Don Yan to monitor CMSP's staff level, introduce "The Code of Conduct" "Job description" and sign contract with the staff.
- 22-26 /3/10 –KRC and TBBC volunteer conducted planning and Management Training at Umphiem camp. 24 Trainees from different CBOs, were attended.
- 24/3/10 – At 09:30 am, KRC's livelihood coordinator met with camp/schools committee, representative of KWO, in Htam Hin Camp for discussion and information sharing on Nursery school lunch support. 13:00-17:00 KRC's livelihood coordinator held a meeting with ZOA area coordinator Kachanaburi, regard to KRC livelihood structure, and explore the outreach farm, together.
- 25/3/10 – KRC livelihood coordinator call on Htam Hin camp committee, VT committee, NGOs and CBOs workers related to the representatives of livelihood and formed the committee.
- 25/3/10 – KRC health coordinator Inquire and discussed Heath situation including nutritious food management in Umphiem with camp Health coordinator.
- 30/3/10 – Health coordinator attended the graduation of LMTC at Mae La on Behalf of KRC.
- 31/3/30 – KRC Health coordinator and secretary received AMI Country Director and his medical team at KRC office.
