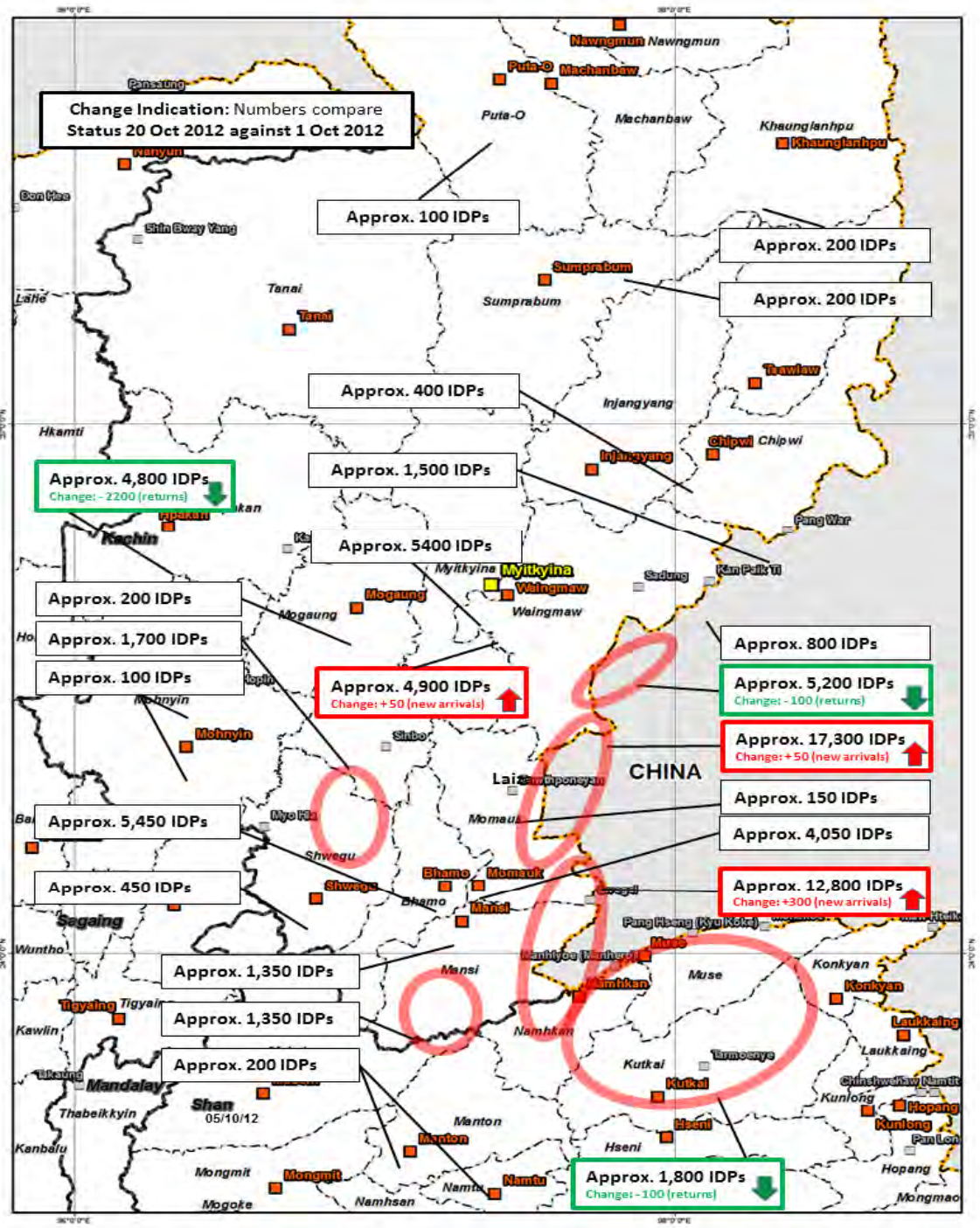


HUMANITARIAN SITUATION IN KACHIN AND RAKHINE

MPG - Yangon, 5 November 2012

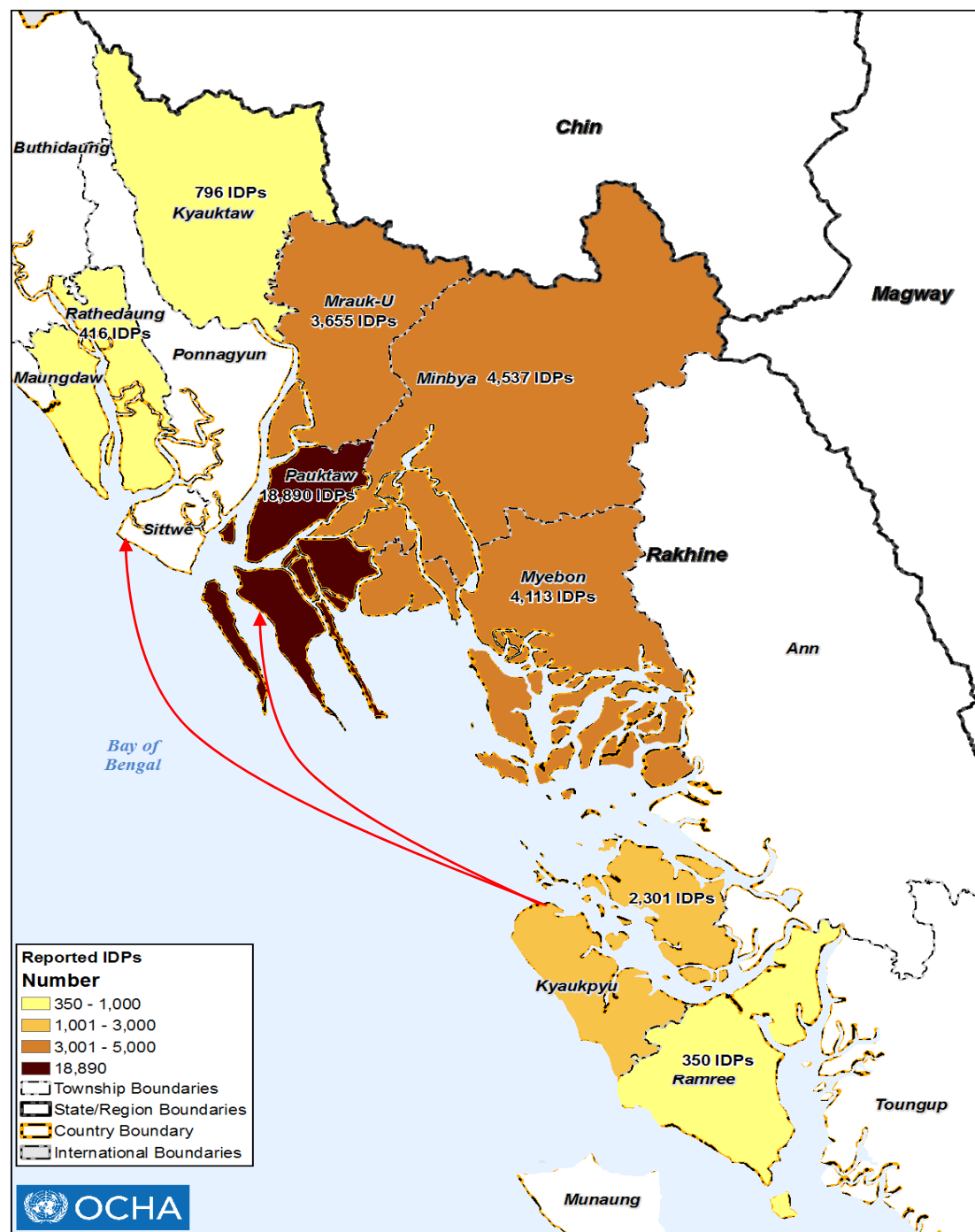


Kachin

- 75,000 IDPs, of which 36,000 fully accessible
- Local partners continue having some degree of access. Convoys on hold since mid-July
- Clashes continue, displacement protracted
- Cold season approaching: NFI, shelter, health concerns
- Monsoon season missed again

RAKHINE

- TOTAL over 110,000 IDPs (75,000 IDPs since June and Over 35,000 since October)

Concerns

- High tensions, physical security for IDPs
- Hostile environment, threats to humanitarian staff
- IDPs scattered in large areas, including in locations where there were no interventions before
- High logistic costs: scattered population, many affected communities can only be reached by water-borne transport
- Shelter/NFI, WASH, health and protection concerns
- Situation in Sittwe camps needs to be addressed as well
- Very limited stocks and funding
- Situation will take time to normalize
- Restriction of movement
- Although access for humanitarian partners is improving by the day, constraints remain
