

THE FOREIGN EXCHANGE REGULATION (AMENDMENT)
ACT, 1954. . . .

[Act No. 71 OF 1954.]

It is hereby enacted as follows:—

1. This Act may be called the Foreign Exchange Regulation (Amendment) Act, 1954.

2. In sub-section (3) of section 20 of the Foreign Exchange Regulation Act, 1947,—

(i) *after* the words “authorize any police officer not below the rank of sub-inspector” the words “or any officer of the Bureau of Special Investigation not below the rank of Senior Investigator” *shall be inserted*; and

(ii) in clause (b), *after* the words “the police officer” the words “or the officer of the Bureau of Special Investigation” *shall be inserted*.
