*Yangon, the 26<sup>th</sup> June 1956.*

No. 298 — The President hereby makes the following amendment to the Myanmar Civil Pensions (Commutation) Rules published with Finance Department Notification No. 19, dated the 19<sup>th</sup> May 1929, as subsequently amended:—\*

1. In the said Rules *for* sub-rule (2) of Rule 2, the following *shall be substituted*: —

“2. (2) On the application of any retired Government servant, Government may sanction commutation of a lump sum payment of a portion, not exceeding one-third, of any pension or anticipatory pension which has been granted to him under the rules, provided that Government may sanction the entire commutation in cases where the pension is K 25 and below and is insufficient to support the pensioner.”

2. This amendment shall take effect from the 4<sup>th</sup> January 1954 and shall apply to Government servants retiring on or after that date. Commutation of pension already sanctioned in cases where Government servants retired on or after the 4<sup>th</sup> January 1954 and prior to the issue of this Notification need not be reviewed.

No. 299 — The President hereby makes the following amendment to the Civil Pensions (Commutation) Rules. Reproduced in Appendix CC to the Myanmar Supplement to the Civil Services Regulations, as subsequently amended:—

1. In the said Rules *for* Rule 4 the following *shall be substituted*:—

“4. On the application of any retired Government servant, Government may sanction commutation of a lump sum payment of a portion, not exceeding one-third, of any pension or anticipatory pension which has been granted to him under the rules, provided that Government may sanction the entire commutation in cases where the pension is K 25 and below and is insufficient to support the pensioner.”

2. This amendment shall take effect from the 4<sup>th</sup> January 1954 and shall apply to Government servants retiring on or after that date. Commutation of pension already sanctioned in cases where Government servants retired on or after the 4<sup>th</sup> January 1954 and prior to the issue of this notification need not be reviewed.

No. 300 — The President directs under section 8(2) of the Provident Funds Act, that the provisions of that Act shall apply to the Provident Fund established for the benefit of the employees of Agricultural and Rural Development Corporation.
