No. 79 — The following amendments to the Rules for the Guidance of Candidates for Myanmar State Scholarships published with this Ministry's Notification No. 18, dated the 24th January 1952, is published for general information: —*

For Rule 12 of the said Rules, the following *shall be substituted*, namely:—

“12. (1) A selected candidate will be required to enter into a security bond in the form contained in Appendix ‘C’ to these Rules and sign the declaration appended to the said bond. The value of the bond to be executed by him jointly with sureties will cover the total expenses including transportation cost actually incurred by the Government on account of the candidate while holding the scholarship. The candidate will be required to offer sureties not less than five in number who will jointly and severally undertake to reimburse the Government the full expenses so incurred, in case of breach of any condition of the bond on the part of the scholar.

(2) The bond shall *inter alia* provide that if a candidate fails or refuses to return after the successful completion of his studies to the Union of Myanmar as and when directed by the Government or its Ambassador or such other persons or agencies as may be authorized by the Government in its behalf, the Government shall terminate ^{his} scholarship forth with, and ^{his} _{her} sureties shall pay to the Government the total expenses actually incurred by the Government on account of the candidate while holding the scholarship.

(3) Security may be either personal or in cash or by mortgage of movable or immovable property to the Government, the matter of acceptance of the security being left to the discretion and responsibility of the Deputy Commissioner (or the Collector in the case of Yangon Town District) in whose jurisdiction the sureties reside. Where personal security is accepted the continued solvency of the sureties will be verified annually. In the event of the death or insolvency of a surety or sureties, the candidate will be required to furnish fresh surety or sureties."

2. In Appendix "C" to the said Rules, for the words "the penal sum of K. 5,000 for breach of any condition" appearing in paragraph 1 of the Form of the Bond to be executed by Myanmar State Scholars, the words "the penal sum which may extend to K 50,000 for breach of any condition" shall be substituted.

3. In Appendix "C" to the said Rules, for paragraph 5 of the form of the Bond to be executed by Myanmar State Scholars the following shall be substituted, namely:—

"AND that in the event of the above bounden making a default in the due observance of any of the conditions hereinabove mentioned the Government of the Union of Myanmar shall terminate ^{his}/_{her} scholarship forthwith and ^{his}/_{her} sureties shall pay to the Government of the Union of Myanmar the total expenses which have been actually paid to the above bounden scholar or on ^{his}/_{her} behalf in respect of the said scholarship including fees, premia, cost of books and travelling expenses plus the interest on the amount calculated at the fixed Government rate then in force for Government loans, and if such total expenses payable have been actually paid to the Government then the above written bond shall be void and of no effect, otherwise it shall be and remain in full force and effect."

APPENDIX "C"

Security Bond to be Executed by Myanmar State Scholars.

KNOW AND MEN by these presents, that we (a) * _____ (Undergoing instructions as a holder of a Myanmar State Scholarship) and (b) * _____

do hereby bind ourselves, and each of us, our heirs, executors, and administrator and each of them to pay to the Government of the Union of Myanmar the penal sum which may extend to K 50,000 for breach of any condition hereinafter mentioned.

WHEREAS the above bounden (a) _____ has been nominated to a Myanmar State Scholarship:

AND WHEREAS the above bounden (a) _____ as a nominee of such scholarship is entitled under the following conditions to & (_____) per annum plus fees, premia, cost of books and travelling expenses in connection with his/her studies and also a second class free passage from Myanmar to the country where the scholarship is tenable and is also eligible for a free return passage to Myanmar unless the scholarship is terminated or unless he/she on or before the completion of his/her course declines to return to Myanmar when directed by the Government of the Union of Myanmar or the Ambassador or such other persons or agencies as may be authorized by the Government of the Union of Myanmar in its behalf.

(a) The full name of the selected candidate for the State Scholarship should be inserted.

Now the conditions of the above written bond are —

- (1) that the above bounden (a) _____
after successful completion of $\frac{\text{his}}{\text{her}}$ studies shall return to Myanmar as and when directed by the Government of the Union of Myanmar or the Ambassador or such other persons or agencies as may be authorized by the Government of the Union of Myanmar in its behalf;
- (2) that $\frac{\text{his}}{\text{her}}$ studies shall not be interrupted owing to $\frac{\text{his}}{\text{her}}$ misconduct, neglect or default;
- (3) that $\frac{\text{he}}{\text{she}}$ on return to Myanmar after successful completion of $\frac{\text{his}}{\text{her}}$ studies, shall serve the Government of the Union of Myanmar continuously for a period of not less than five years, when required by the Government to do so, in such capacity as the Government may deem fit and upon such terms as are ordinarily applicable to $\frac{\text{him}}{\text{her}}$ under the rules for the time being in force;
- (4) that $\frac{\text{he}}{\text{she}}$ shall not marry during the tenure of the scholarship;
- (5) that in the case of prolonged illness of the scholar in the country in which the scholarship is enable $\frac{\text{his}}{\text{her}}$ surety or sureties shall pay to the Government of the Union of Myanmar all the expenses which may have been incurred for medical treatment when called upon to do so;

AND that in the event of the above bounden making a default in the due observance of any of the conditions hereinabove mentioned the Government of the Union of Myanmar shall terminate $\frac{\text{his}}{\text{her}}$ scholarship forthwith, and $\frac{\text{his}}{\text{her}}$ sureties shall pay to the Government of the Union of Myanmar the total expenses which have been actually paid to the above bounden scholar or on $\frac{\text{his}}{\text{her}}$
