No.357 — The President hereby makes the following amendment to the Myanmar Extraordinary Pension Rules*, published with the Government of Myanmar, Finance Department Notification No.84, dated the 25th July 1941, as subsequently amended: —

1. In the said Rules, for Rule 12(i)(a), the following *shall be substituted*: —

“12(1)(a) A gratuity of the applicable amount specified in Schedule 111. If the deceased Government servant has not left a widow, the above gratuity may be paid to the children individually or collectively, and”.

11. In the said Rules, for Rule 13(1), the following *shall be substituted*:—

“13(1) If the deceased Government servant has left neither a widow nor a child, either ‘gratuity and pension’ or ‘pension’ alone, as the case may be, not exceeding the applicable amounts specified in Schedule III may be paid to his father and his mother individually or jointly and in the absence of the father and the mother, to minor brothers and sisters, individually or collectively, if they were largely dependent on the Government servant for support and are in pecuniary need: —

Provided that the total amounts of the pensions only shall not exceed one half of the pension that would have been admissible to the widow under Rule 12.

Provided further that each minor brother's and sister's share of pension shall not exceed the amount specified in Schedule III for a child who is not motherless.”

111. In the said Rules, the following Note *shall be inserted* below Rule 14(3): —

“Note — No gratuity is admissible to a dependent mentioned in Rule 12(1)(a) and Rule 13(1) if he or she is not also entitled to a Pension under Rule 12, 13 and 14.”

2. The above amendments shall take effect from the 1st July 1956.
