No.96 — The following proviso shall be sub-joined to the existing Rule 17 of the Rules for the Guidance of Candidates for Myanmar State Scholarships published with this Ministry's Notification No. 18, dated the 24th January 1952:—

“ Provided that a permanent Government servant or a Government servant officiating in a permanent or a temporary post without holding a lien on any substantive appointment continuously for a period of 3 years, and if the Administrative Ministry concerned certifies that such a Government servant will eventually be absorbed in the permanent cadre of the service to which he belongs may not be required to resign his service under Government, if the award is made to pursue a course of study bearing direct relation to his work and if that course of study is offered at the instance of the Administrative Ministry under which he or she is working. In such cases, the Government servant may be sent on deputation under the terms and conditions set out in the Ministry of Finance and Revenue memorandum No. 13 Ba Ma (6) 55, dated the 9th June 1955, as amended from time to time, by the Ministries concerned in consultation with the Ministry of Finance and Revenue.”
