

**THE MYANMAR IMMIGRATION (EMERGENCY PROVISIONS)
(AMENDMENT) ACT, 1957.***

[Act No. XXXIX OF 1957.]
(The 11th October 1957)

It is hereby enacted as follows : —

1. This Act may be called the Myanmar Immigration (Emergency Provisions) (Amendment) Act, 1957

2. In section 7 of the Myanmar Immigration (Emergency Provisions) Act, 1947:—

(a) after sub-section (1), the following shall be inserted as sub-sections (2) and (3) thereof, namely:—

“(2) The President of the Union or any such authority as may be appointed by him under this sub-section, may, in lieu of prosecution, order any foreigner who contravenes any of the provisions of this Act, or the rules made thereunder, to be deported from the Union of Myanmar and pending orders of deportation such foreigner may be detained in such manner as the President of the Union may direct and whilst so detained shall be deemed to be in legal custody.

(3) The President of the Union or the authority competent to order deportation under sub-section (2) shall have power to adjudge if any foreigner has in fact contravened any of the provisions of this Act, or the rules made thereunder.”;

(b) the existing sub-sections (2), (3) and (4) shall be renumbered as sub-sections (4), (5) and (6) respectively ;

- (c) *for the words and figure "sub-section(1)" in sub-section (4) as re-numbered, the words and figures "sub-section (1) or sub-section (2)" shall be substituted ;*
- (d) *for the words and figures "sub-section (1) or sub-section (2)" in sub-section (5) as re-numbered, the words and figures "sub-section (1) or sub-section (2) or sub-section (4)" shall be substituted ; and*
- (e) *for the words and figure "sub-section (1)" in sub-section (6) as re-numbered, the words and figures "sub-section (1) or sub-section (2)" shall be substituted.*
