

**THE MYANMAR IMMIGRATION (EMERGENCY PROVISIONS)
(AMENDMENT) ACT, 1958***

[Act No. XVI OF 1958.]

(The 24th March 1958)

It is hereby enacted as follows:—

1. This Act may be called the Myanmar Immigration (Emergency Provisions) (Amendment) Act, 1958.

2. In section 2 of the Myanmar Immigration (Emergency Provisions) Act, 1947, hereinafter referred to as the said Act, *for* the words "an Immigration Constable" in clause (f) of sub-section (1) the words "a Junior Immigration Assistant " *shall be substituted.*

3. In section 6 of the said Act, *for* the words "Sub-Inspector of Immigration" in clauses (a) and (b) of sub-section (2) the words "Immigration Assistant " *shall be substituted.*

4. In section 12 of the said Act, *for* the words "above the rank of Sub-Inspector of Immigration" the words "not below the rank of Assistant Immigration Officer " *shall be substituted.*
