

THE TRADE DISPUTES (AMENDMENT) ACT, 1958.¹

[Act No.XXXVI OF 1958]

(The 12th December 1958)

It is hereby enacted as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be called the Trade Disputes (Amendment) Act, 1958.

(2) It shall come into force on such date² as the President may, by notification, appoint in that behalf.

2. In section 2 of the Trade Disputes Act hereinafter referred to as the said Act, —

(a) after sub-clause (ii) of clause (g) the following shall be inserted as sub clause (iii), namely:—

" (iii) any air transport service carrying passengers and operated under the provisions of the Union of Myanmar Airways Board Act, 1952, or any other air transport service, which the President of the Union may, by notification, declare to be a public utility service for the purposes of this Act; or";

(b) the existing sub-clauses (iii),(iv),(v) and (vi) thereof shall be re-numbered as sub-clauses (iv),(v),(vi) and (vii) respectively.

3. In section 27 of the said Act,—

(a) after sub-section (2) the following shall be inserted as sub-section (2A), namely:—

" (2A) The President of the Union may, by notification, appoint Assistant Conciliation Officers to assist Conciliation Officers and they shall exercise such powers and perform such duties of the Conciliation Officer as may be delegated to them by the President of the Union."

- (b) in sub-section (3A), *after* the words "Conciliation Officer" the words " or Assistant Conciliation Officer" *shall be inserted*;
- (c) in sub-section (4), *for* the words "Conciliation Officer" wherever they occur the words "Conciliation Officer or Assistant Conciliation Officer" *shall be substituted*;
- (d) in sub-section (5), *after* the words "Conciliation Officer" the words "or Assistant Conciliation Officer" *shall be inserted*; and
- (e) in sub-section (6), *for* the words "Conciliation Officer" wherever they occur the words "Conciliation Officer or Assistant Conciliation Officer" *shall be substituted*;
