

THE MYANMAR TELEGRAPH (AMENDMENT) ACT, 1958.*

[Act, No. XXXVII OF 1958.]

(The 12th December 1958)

It is hereby enacted as follows:—

1. This Act may be called the Myanmar Telegraph (Amendment) Act, 1958.

2. In section 3 of the Myanmar Telegraph Act, hereinafter referred to as the said Act, for clause (7) the following shall be substituted as clause (7); namely:—

“(7). ‘local authority’ means any municipal committee, town committee, district board, district council, board of management for ports or other authority, legally entitled to, or entrusted by the Government with, the control or management of any municipal or local fund”.

3. In section 4 of the said Act, sub section (2) shall be deleted.

4. In section 6 of the said Act, after the word “company” wherever it occurs the expression “or railway board” shall be inserted.**

5. *After section 33 of the said Act, the following shall be inserted as section 34 , namely:—*

“34. The President of the Union may, by notification, delegate, either absolutely or subject to conditions, to the telegraph authority all or any of the powers conferred upon the President of the Union by this Act, other than the power to make rules.”

Delegation of powers other than rule-making power to the telegraph authority.
