

THE OUTPORTS ACT AMENDING LAW, 1962.

[THE UNION OF BURMA REVOLUTIONARY COUNCIL LAW No. 20 OF 1962.]

The Chairman of the Union of Burma Revolutionary Council makes the following Law :—

1. (1) This Law may be called the Outports Act Amending Law, 1962.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. In section 2 of the Outports Act hereinafter referred to as the said Act, *for* clause (c) the following *shall be substituted* as clause (c); namely:—

“(c) ‘Port Officer’ means any person appointed by the Board of Management for the Port of Rangoon to be a Port Officer for the purposes of this Act.”

3. *For* section 6 of the said Act, the following *shall be substituted* as section 6; namely:—

“6. All dues levied under this Act shall be credited to the Burma Ports Fund maintained by the Board of Management for the Port of Rangoon under section 43 of the Rangoon Port Act.”

4. In section 7, sub-section (5) of the said Act, *for* the expression “Port Fund Account” the expression “Burma Ports Fund maintained by the Board of Management for the Port of Rangoon under section 43 of the Rangoon Port Act” *shall be substituted*.
