

**THE PRESS (EMERGENCY POWERS) ACT AMENDING LAW,  
1962.**

**[THE UNION OF BURMA REVOLUTIONARY COUNCIL LAW, No. 27 OF 1962.]**

The Chairman of the Union of Burma Revolutionary Council makes the following Law:—

1. (1) This Law may be called the Press (Emergency Powers) Act Amending Law, 1962.

(2) It shall come into force on such date as the Revolutionary Government of the Union of Burma may, by notification, appoint.

2. In clause (4) of section 2 of the Press (Emergency Powers) Act hereinafter called the said Act, for the words "District Magistrate" the words "Magistrate of the first class" shall be substituted.

3. In section 16 of the said Act, for the words "Magistrate of the first class" wherever they occur the word "Magistrate" shall be substituted.

4. In section 17 of the said Act, for the words "or Subdivisional Magistrate" the words "Subdivisional Magistrate or Magistrate" shall be substituted.

5. In the said Act, for the words "High Court" wherever they occur the words "Chief Court" shall be substituted.
