

FOREST (AMENDMENT) ACT, 1947.

[BURMA ACT NO. XVIII OF 1947.]

[12th April 1947.]

WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend the Forest Act, 1902 (Burma IV of 1902);

AND WHEREAS by Proclamation, dated the tenth day of December, 1942, the Governor of Burma has assumed to himself all powers vested by or under the Government of Burma Act, 1935, in the Legislature or in either Chamber thereof;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the said powers, it is hereby enacted by the Governor of Burma as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be called the Forest (Amendment) Act, 1947.  
Short title.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. For sub-section (1) of section 62 of the Forest Act, the following Amendment of section 62, Burma IV, 1902. shall be substituted:—

“The Governor may, by notification, empower a Forest Officer in charge of a range or ranges, a Forest Ranger, or any Forest Officer of higher rank,—”

3. The Forest (Amendment) Act, 1946 (Burma Act No. XXXV of 1946), is hereby repealed.
