

THE TENANCY STANDARD RENT ACT, 1947.

[BURMA ACT No. LXXVIII OF 1947.]

[9th December 1947.]

It is hereby enacted as follows:—

1. This Act shall extend to such areas as the Governor may, from time to time, by notification, appoint.

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in the Tenancy Act, 1946, or any agreement to the contrary, the standard rent of an agricultural land cultivated with paddy for the tenancy year 1947-48 shall be reckoned as twice the amount of the land revenue payable in respect of such land;

3. The standard rent shall be payable either in cash or kind.
