

THE PRESS (REGISTRATION) (AMENDMENT) ACT, 1950.

[Act No. XII of 1950.]

1. This Act may be called the Press (Registration) (Amendment) Act, 1950.

2. In section 9 of the Press (Registration) Act, as amended by the Union of Burma Adaptation of Laws Order, 1948, (hereinafter referred to as the said Act), for clause (b) substitute the following, namely :—

“(b) within six calendar months from such date, (if the book be not proscribed by Government) four other such copies,”.

3. For section 11 of the said Act, substitute the following, namely :—

“11. Of the copies delivered pursuant to section 9, one copy each shall be transmitted to the Union Parliament Library, the Rangoon University Library, and the Bernard Free Library, and the remainder shall be disposed of as the President of the Union shall from time to time determine.”.
