

THE BURMA TARIFF (AMENDMENT) ACT, 1950.

[ACT NO. XXXIII OF 1950.]

It is hereby enacted as follows :—

1. (1) This Act shall extend to the whole of the Union of Burma.

Commencement
and extent.

(2) It shall come into force on the 8th September 1950.
