

THE ESSENTIAL SUPPLIES AND SERVICES (FOURTH  
AMENDMENT) ACT, 1950.

[Act No. XLIX of 1950.]

It is hereby enacted as follows :—

1. This Act may be called "The Essential Supplies and Services (Fourth Amendment) Act, 1950."

2. In section 3 of the Essential Supplies and Services Act, 1947, *after* clause (1B) the following *shall be inserted* as clause (1C), namely :—

"(1C) for regulating or prohibiting the use, keeping, movement or disposal of animals employed in connection with any timber industry ;"
