

THE WILD LIFE PROTECTION (AMENDMENT) ACT, 1956

[ACT No. VI OF 1956.]

It is hereby enacted as follows :—

1. This Act may be called the Wild Life Protection (Amendment) Act, 1956.

2. In section 6 of the Wild Life Protection Act, hereinafter referred to as the said Act, for the words "Rhinoceros, tapir, argus pheasant, masked finfoot" the words "Rhinoceros, tapir, *thamin*, argus pheasant, masked finfoot, peafowl" shall be substituted.

3. In section 7 of the said Act, the word "*thamin*," shall be deleted.

4. In section 8 of the said Act, the word "Peafowl" shall be deleted.

5. In section 17 of the said Act—

- (i) for the word "fifty" in clause (a) of sub-section (1) thereof, the words "five hundred" shall be substituted;
- (ii) for the words "the value" in clause (b) of sub-section (1) thereof, the words "a sum of money equivalent to double the value" shall be substituted; and
- (iii) for the words "sum of money, or such value, or both" in sub-section (2) thereof, the words "sum or sums of money" shall be substituted.
