

THE CINEMATOGRAPH (AMENDMENT) ACT, 1957.

[ACT No. XXXIV OF 1957.]

It is hereby enacted as follows :—

1. (1) This Act may be called the Cinematograph (Amendment) Act, 1957.

(2) It shall come into force on such date as the President of the Union may, by notification, appoint.

2. In sub-section (4) of section 5 of the Cinematograph Act, *for* the words “so that indigenous films” the words “so that scientific films, films intended for educational purposes, films dealing with news and current events, documentary films or indigenous films” *shall be substituted.*
