

The State Law and Order Restoration Council
The Law Amending the Myanmar Merchant Shipping Act
(The State Law and Order Restoration Council Law No.10/89)
The 11th Waning Day of *Tabaung*, 1350 M.E.
(1st April, 1989)

The State Law and Order Restoration Council hereby enacts the following Law:-

1. This Law shall be called the Law Amending the Myanmar Merchant Shipping Act.
2. In the Myanmar Merchant Shipping Act:-
 - (a) section 25 sub-section (1) and (2) shall be substituted by the following sub-sections:-
 - (1) A person shall not engage or supply a seaman to be entered on board any ship unless that person holds a licence under this Act for this purpose.
 - (2) A person shall not employ any person, for the purpose of engaging or supplying a seaman to be entered on board any ship, unless that person holds a licence under this Act for this purpose.
 - (b) the expression "one hundred kyats" contained in sub-section (4) of section 25 shall be substituted by the expression "ten thousand kyats"
 - (c) section 26 sub-section (2) shall be substituted by the following sub-section:-
 - (2) If a person acts in contravention of this section, he shall, for each such offence, be punishable with imprisonment for a term which may extend to three years and with fine which may extend to fifty thousand kyats, and also his licence forfeited.
