YANGON, 2 Sept-Chairman of the Committee for Boosting Fish and Meat Production and Marine Production and Commodities Price Control Committee

Minister for Commerce Lt-Gen Tun Kyi, accompanied by Minister for Livestock and Fisheries U Aung Thaug, Deputy Minister for Labour U Kyaw Aye and Director-General of Fisheries Department U Soe Win, inspected 500-ton Cold Storage & Processing Plant of United KMK Co Ltd on Setsan Street, Mingala Taungnyunt Township, this afternoon.

Managing Director U Khin Maung Kyaw of United KMK Co Ltd reported on its objective, type and capacity of the plant, organizational setup, purchase of raw materials, export and future tasks.

The minister gave instructions on export of high quality fish and prawn.

The ministers, the deputy minister and officials inspected dressing of fish and prawn, processing and packaging at the plant.

The cold storage can hold 16 tons of deep and fresh water prawn, whole fish and fillet daily.

Finished products of various kinds of prawn and fish are exported to Australia, European Common Market countries, Japan, Singapore, Hong Kong, Malaysia, China, Middle East countries and the United States.

YANGON, 2 Sept-Tentatively Myanmar selected national team and Vietnam national team played a goalless draw in the goodwill match at Thuwunna Youth Training Centre Stadium today.
