(1) Secretary-1 attends Second Myanmar-Singapore Ministerial Working Committee Meeting

YANGON, 4 Oct-The delegation comprising ministers and departmental officials led by Secretary-1 of the State Law and Order Restoration Council Lt-Gen Khin Nyunt left here by air at 8.15 am on 3 October for Singapore to attend the Second Myanmar-Singapore Ministerial Working Committee Meeting. They arrived at Changi International Airport in Singapore at 12.15 pm local time.

The Secretary-1 and party were welcomed at the airport by members of welcoming party led by Minister for Communications of Singapore Mr Mah Bow Tan, Ambassador of Singapore to Myanmar Brig-Gen Patrick Choy Choong Tow, Myanmar Ambassador U Myo Myint and Embassy staff.

The Secretary-1 and party went by motorcade to Shangri-La Hotel.

Minister Mr Mah Bow Tan hosted luncheon in honour of the Secretary-1 and party at the hotel.

At 2.45 pm, Secretary-1 Lt-Gen Khin Nyunt called on Deputy Prime Minister of the Republic of Singapore Brig-Gen Lee Hsien Loong at his office in the Treasury Building.

They discussed on strengthening of bilateral relations and extension of new sectors in cooperation.

Present together with the Secretary-1 were Minister for Hotels and Tourism Lt-Gen Kyaw Ba, Minister for National Planning and Economic Development Brig-Gen Abel, Minister for Transport Lt-Gen Thein Win, Chairman of Yangon City Development Committee Mayor U Ko Lay, Deputy Minister for Foreign Affairs U Nyunt Swe, Myanmar Ambassador U Myo Myint and Ambassador of Singapore Brig-Gen Patrick Choy Choong Tow.

Secretary-1 Lt-Gen Khin Nyunt paid a courtesy call on Prime Minister of Singapore Mr Goh Chok Tong at his office at 3.30 pm.

The Secretary-1 discussed bilateral relations, development in Myanmar and bilateral cooperation.

Prime Minister Mr Goh Chok Tong said Singapore considers Myanmar a very friendly nation. He expressed his wish to promote bilateral relations and cooperation. Singapore is ready to help Myanmar in ASEAN affairs as she has become an ASEAN member, he added.

Together with Prime Minister Mr Goh Chok Tong were Minister for Trade and Industry Mr Lee Yock Suan, Ambassador of Singapore Brig-Gen Patrick Choy Choong Two and senior officials.

Together with the Secretary-1 were also Minister for Hotels and Tourism Lt-Gen Kyaw Ba, Minister for National Planning and Economic Development Brig-Gen Abel, Minister for Transport Lt-Gen Thein Win, Chairman of Yangon City Development Committee Mayor U Ko Lay, Deputy Minister for Foreign Affairs U Nyunt Swe and Myanmar Ambassador U Myo Myint.

Director of Intelligence of the Ministry of Defence of Singapore Brig-Gen Choi Shing Kwok called on the Secretary-1 at Shangri-La Hotel.

At 7 pm, Minister Mr Lee Yock Suan hosted dinner in honour of the Secretary-1 and party at the Singapore Museum of Arts.

Before dinner, the Secretary-1 and party, accompanied by Minister Mr Lee Yock Suan, viewed works of Leonardo da Vinci at the Museum of Arts.

The Secretary-1 and party went to Myanmar Embassy where they were welcomed by Ambassador U Myo Nyunt, embassy staff and families.

Meeting with embassy staff, the Secretary-1 spoke at length on strengthening of Myanmar-Singapore goodwill relations, raising momentum in bilateral economic cooperation. mutual cooperation among ASEAN member nations, true political and economic situation, endeavours at all sectors for national economic development and important role of diplomats in Myanmar-Singapore bilateral relations.

(3) Air Force wins championship trophy of Defence Services C-in-C's Trophy Under-21 Soccer Tournery

YANGON, 4 Oct-Air Force won the championship trophy of Defence Services Commander-in-Chief's Trophy Tatmadaw (Army, Navy and Air) Under-21 Soccer Tournament 1997 after beating Yangon Command 2-0 in the final at Aung San Stadium this evening.

The final and the prize distribution ceremony were attended by Chief of Bureau of Special Operations Chief of Staff (Army) Lt-Gen Tin Oo, Adjutant-General Lt-Gen Win Myint, Commander in Chief (Air) Lt-Gen Tin Ngwe, Minister for Sports Brig-Gen Sein Win, Commander of Yangon Command Maj-Gen Khin Maung Than, Chief of Staff-(Air) Brig-Gen Kyaw Than, Vice-Adjutant-General Brig-Gen Than Tun, Commander of No 11 LID Brig-Gen Thura Shwe Man, Commander of Mingaladon Air Base Brig-Gen Ba Htay Chit and senior military officers. (6) Factories striving for producing 6,000 power-tillers

YANGON, 4 Oct - The Agricultural Equipment Factory, 9th Mile Pyay Road, and Ingon Factory are striving to produce 6,000 powertillers in time for cultivation of summer paddy this year.

Altogether 1,080 engines and gear-boxes for the machines were imported from the People's Republic of China and they arrived at Yangon Port yesterday.

It is targeted to cultivate monsoon paddy on 12 million acres and summer paddy on four million acres, and the Ministry of Agriculture and Irrigation is striving for realization of this target with effective use of agricultural equipment and implements.

(7) Fourth collective sanitation done at Kaba Aye

YANGON, 4 Oct - The fourth collective sanitation work was carried out at the surrounding areas of Kaba Aye Pagoda this morning.
