

**Introduction**

January is the first of the year. For many, it is the month of preparation for the rest of the year. For the Karen Refugee Committee, as a preparation, we organized our annual meeting for 2019 on January 30-31. During this two-days meeting, we review our works and activities, condition of refugees existing for the last 40 years. At the same time, we revisit our vision/mission that we have laid down, reviewing our camp management support for all camps, reviewing our return's position, and identify the challenges while reaching out to refugee communities. During this meeting, all representatives from camps have agreed to also form KRC's return committee, names as 'Refugee Future Preparedness Committee'. This Committee will serve as the main body in supporting refugee future preparation.

In relation to KRC's return position, it will depend solely on KRC's Vision, which states that, 'For the refugees to live in self-reliance'. In order to fulfill this vision, KRC, Camp Committee will continue to work on to fulfill with the support and cooperation from the refugees. For this coming 2020, we also plan to meet with religious leaders/organizations in Burma, having consultation meeting with CBOs/CSOs leaders in Burma and along the border and from other countries, to meet with Burma's State Government and KNU leaders. If opportunity opens up, we hope to see a few families to return as an initial step for preparation for their family's future in this year 2020. We continue to thank Thai Royal Government, donors, UNHCR, INGOs, NGOs and CBOs for your continuous year-long support for the refugees.


