

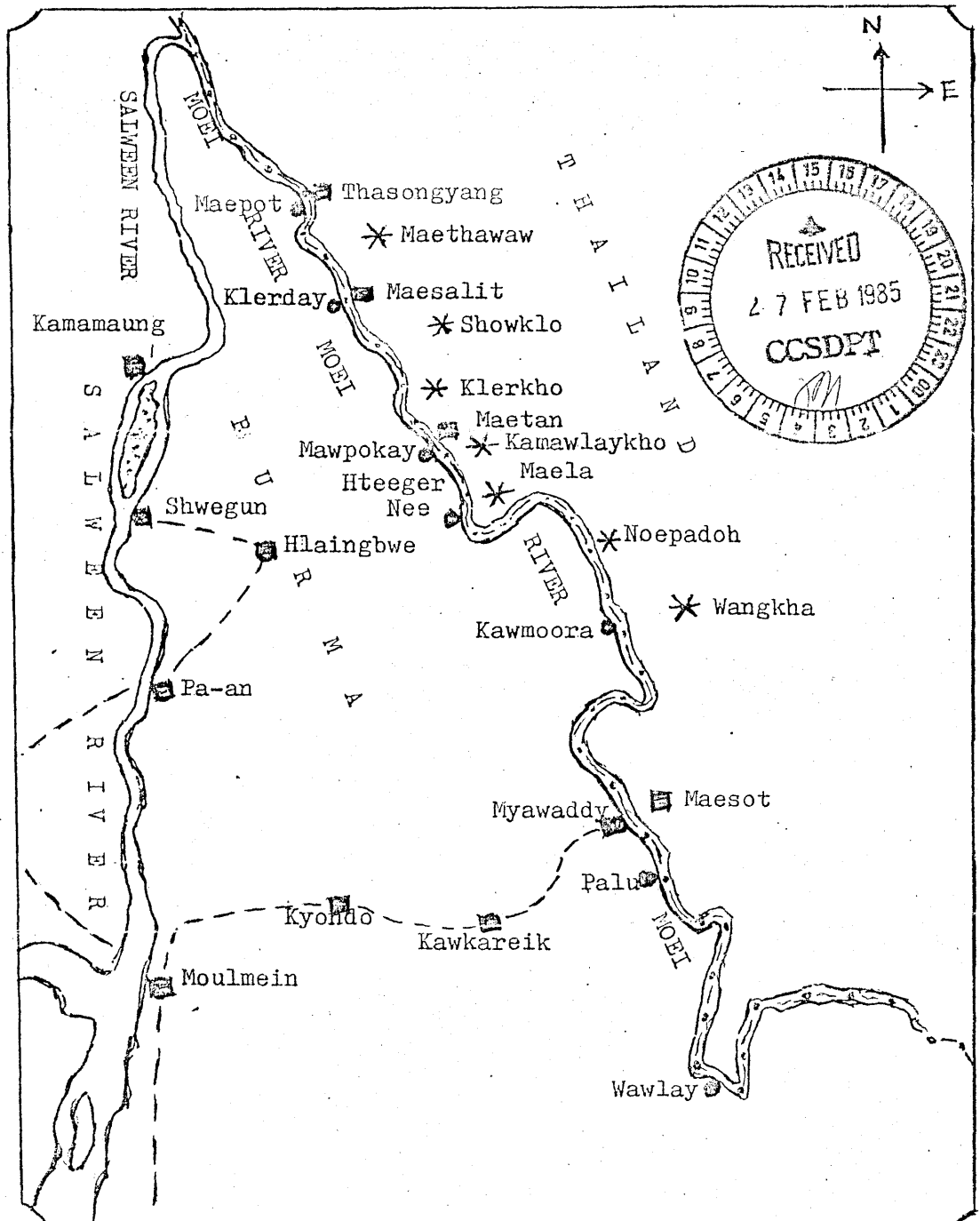

To each of the agencies and individuals who provided assistance to the Karen refugees during the month of February we give our thanks. Without your generous support the situation for the Karen refugees would be unbearable. As we are totally dependent upon the assistance of outside sources we are deeply grateful for your support. Through your help we receive not only the physical necessities, but also much needed encouragement and we can experience God's continued grace and mercy.

During the month of February more Karen civilians were forced to flee their villages due to the increased" danger from the civil war raging in their areas of Burma, destroying villages, farms, live-stocks and killing many an innocent victim. Some of the new refugees had to walk for 4 days to reach the safety of the refugee camps. Their stories are clear indications that it is not safe for them to stay on the Burmese side of the border.
