

Pyithu Hluttaw representatives meet for vice-president nomination



NAY PYI TAW, 1 Feb- Speaker of Pyithu Hluttaw Thura U Shwe Mann and Pyithu Hluttaw representatives from States and Regions met at Pyithu Hluttaw Hall in Hluttaw Building here at 10 am today for nomination of vice-president.

The Pyithu Hluttaw Speaker supervised the election process and Deputy Director-General U Kyaw Soe of Hluttaw Office acted as master of ceremonies.

First, Hluttaw representatives took out proposals from the deputy director-general to nominate candidates for vicepresidency.

Next, representatives presented proposals describing facts about nominees to the Pyithu Hluttaw Speaker through the master of ceremonies.

U Thein Sein from Zabuthiri Constituency was nominated by Daw Dwebu from M'Jangyang Constituency and seconded by U Aik Mone of Mantung Constituency. U Thein Sein was also proposed by U Tin Aye from TadaU Constituency and seconded by U Htay Oo from Hinthada Constituency.

U Saw Thein Aung from Hlaingbwe Constituency was nominated by Daw Tin Ngwe Oo from Dagon (North) Constituency and Daw Nan Wah Nu from Kunhein Constituency and Daw Khin Saw Wai from Yathaedaung Constituency seconded the candidacy. He also got nomination by Daw Nan Sae Auh from Hpa-an Constituency and Daw Myint Than from Ye Constituency and Daw Tin Ngwe Oo from Dagon Myothit (North) Constituency seconded the candidacy. He was proposed by U Ngun MOUNG from Haka Constituency and U Pai Lin from Paletwa Constituency and Daw Zatalem from Thantlang Constituency seconded the candidacy.

The two nominees for the vice-president were U Thein Sein from Zabuthiri Constituency and U Saw Thein Aung from Hlaingbwe Constituency.

Then, the meeting of Pyithu Hluttaw representatives was adjourned for a day so that the Pyithu Hluttaw Speaker and the Deputy Speaker may have time to recognize proposals and list the names of the nominees.
