

THE UNION JUDICIARY (AMENDMENT) ACT, 1951.

[ACT No. VIII of 1951.]

It is hereby enacted as follows :—

1. This Act may be called the Union Judiciary (Amendment) Act, 1951.

2. In sub-section (1) of section 26 of the Union Judiciary Act, 1948, for the words "The High Court shall have power to approve, admit and enrol such persons as advocates as to the High Court may seem meet ; and such advocates shall thereby be authorized to appear for the suitors of the High Court ", the words "Persons enrolled to be advocates under the law for the time being in force shall be entitled to appear for the suitors of the High Court " *shall be substituted*.
