## THE EMERGENCY PROVISIONS (REPEAL) ACT, 1947.

[BURMA ACT No. I of 1947:]

Whereas it is expedient to repeal the Emergency Provisions Act, 1943;

AND WHEREAS by Proclamation, dated the tenth day of December, 1942, the Governor of Burma has assumed to himself all powers vested by or under the Government of Burma Act, 1935, in the Legislature or in either Chamber thereof;

Now, THEREFORE, in exercise of the said powers, it is hereby enacted as follows:—

- 1. (1) This Act may be called the Emergency Provisions (Repeal) Act, 1947.
  - (2) It shall come into force at once.
- 2. The Emergency Provisions Act, 1943, as subsequently amended, hereinafter referred to as the said Act, is hereby repealed.
- 3. Nothing contained in clause (d) of section 5 of the Burm General Clauses Act shall apply to the repeal of section 7a of the said Act, and the repeal of section 7a of the said Act shall be deemed to have been made as if clause (d) of section 5 of the Burma General Clauses Act had been deleted in respect of the repeal of the aforesaid section 7a.
