

THE PUBLIC PROPERTY PROTECTION (AMENDMENT)
ACT, 1951.

[Act No. XVII of 1951.]

It is hereby enacted as follows :—

1. This Act may be called the Public Property Protection (Amendment) Act, 1951.

2. In section 2 of the Public Property Protection Act, 1947, hereinafter referred to as "the Act",—

(a) in clause (i), the comma (,) *after* the words "local authority" and the words "or any Board or Body" *shall be deleted*; and

(b) in clause (ii) (b), *after* the expression "the Public Utilities Protection Act, 1947," the expression "the Foreign Exchange Regulation Act, 1947," *shall be inserted*.

3. In section 7 of the Act,—

(a) *for* sub-section (2), the following *shall be substituted*, namely :—

"(2) Any officer authorized in this behalf by general or special order by the President of the Union may, if he is satisfied with respect to any particular person that with a view to preventing him from committing any prejudicial act it is necessary so to do, arrest him without warrant"; and

(b) in sub-section (5), *for* the words "temporary custody" the word "detention" *shall be substituted*.

4. In sub-section (1) of section 8 of the Act,—

(i) in clause (b), *after* the words "such person" the words "or to any other person dependent on him, or relating to any property kept in the safe custody of the bank in the name of such person or of any other person dependent on him" *shall be inserted*; and

(ii) in clause (c), *after* the words "such person" the words "or of any other person dependent on him or from delivering any property kept in the safe custody of the bank in the name of such person or any other person dependent on him," *shall be inserted*.
