

THE NEGOTIABLE INSTRUMENTS (AMENDMENT)  
ACT, 1951.

[ACT No. XXV OF 1951.]

It is hereby enacted as follows :—

1. For the *explanation* to section 25 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, the following *shall be substituted*, namely :—

“*Explanation*—the expression ‘public holiday’ includes Sundays and any other day declared by the President of the Union, by notification, to be a public holiday.”
