THE UNION OF BURMA CONTINGENCY FUND ACT, 1951.

[Act No. 31 of 1951.]

1. (1) This Act may be called the Union of Burma Contingency Fund Act, 1951.

(2) It shall come into force on the 1st October 1951.

2. There shall be established a contingency fund in the nature of an imprest entitled the Union of Burma Contingency Fund, into which shall be paid from and out of the revenues of the Union of Burma a sum of Rupees One crore.

3. The Union of Burma Contingency Fund shall be held on behalf of the President by the Ministry of Finance and Revenue, and no advances shall be made out of the Fund except for the purposes of meeting unforeseen expenditure pending authorization of such expenditure by Parliament under appropriations made by law.

4. For the purpose of carrying out the objects of this Act, the President may make rules regulating all matters connected with or ancillary to the custody of, the payment of moneys into and the withdrawals of money from, the Union of Burma Contingency Fund.
