

THE UNIVERSITY OF RANGOON (AMENDMENT) ACT, 1951.

[Act No. XLII of 1951.]

It is hereby enacted as follows :—

1. (1) This Act may be called the University of Rangoon (Amendment) Act, 1951.

(2) This Act shall come into force at once except clause (i) of section 5 which shall come into force on the date on which the University of Rangoon (Temporary Amendment) Act, 1949, is declared by the President under the said Act to be no longer in force.

2. In the University of Rangoon Act (hereinafter referred to as "the Act"), for the word "Administrator" wherever it occurs the word "Rector" *shall be substituted*.

3. In section 4 of the Act,—

(i) in clause (a) for the words "to make provision for research and for the advancement and dissemination of knowledge" the words "to train scholars, specialists and technicians in all fields of human activities, having regard to the socio-economic needs of the country" *shall be substituted* ;

(ii) after clause (a) as amended the following *shall be inserted* as clause (aa), namely :—

"(aa) to make provision for research and for the advancement and dissemination of knowledge ;"

4. In sub-section (1) of section 9 of the Act, after the words "such salary" the words "or allowance" *shall be inserted*.

5. In sub-section (1) of section 11 of the Act,—

(i) for clause (g) the following *shall be substituted*, namely :—

"(g) one member, not being a member of the University staff or a student in the University, for every 100 registered graduates of the University elected from among themselves by such graduates ; provided that the total number of members so elected shall not be less than three or more than five ;"

(ii) in clause (i) for the words "each elected by the Municipal Corporation of the City of Rangoon and Mandalay Municipality" the words "elected by the Municipal Corporation of the City of Rangoon" *shall be substituted* ;

(iii) for clause (k) the following *shall be substituted*, namely :—

"(k) two graduates, not being members of the University staff or students in the University, nominated by the Executive Council of the Rangoon University Students' Union. Such members shall hold office for a period of one year and shall be eligible for reappointment ;"

(iv) in clause (l) after the words "one member" the words " , not being a member of the University staff or a student in the University," *shall be inserted* ;

(v) for clause (m) the following *shall be substituted*, namely :—

“(m) three members, not being members of the University staff or students in the University, appointed by the Chancellor;” ;

(vi) after clause (m) as amended, the following *shall be inserted as clause (n)*, namely :—

“(n) two Secretaries to the Government in each of the Ministries of Education and Finance ; and,”

(vii) after clause (n) as inserted the following *shall be inserted as clause (o)*, namely :—

“(o) one representative of the Governing Body of the University College, Mandalay.”

(viii) in sub-section (3) of section 11 of the Act, after the italicised word “*ex-officio*” the words “ and those under clause (k) of sub-section (1),” *shall be inserted*.

6. In section 12 of the Act,—

(i) for sub-section (3) the following *shall be substituted*, namely :—

“(3) Annual Budget Estimates of the University shall be prepared by the Rector for presentation to the Council and transmission to Government with such recommendations as the Council may deem necessary. If and when demands for Supplementary Grants are necessary they shall be made to Government through the Council.”

(ii) in sub-section (4) after the word “ officers ” the words “ and business ” *shall be inserted*.

7. In clause (e) of sub-section (1) of section 14 of the Act, after the words “ the Professors ” the words “ who are Heads of the Departments of Studies in the University ” *shall be inserted*.

8. In section 19 of the Act,—

(i) after sub-section (5) the following *shall be inserted as sub-section (6)*, namely :—

“(6) Annual Budget Estimates of every affiliated college shall be prepared and transmitted by the Governing Body to Government. However, the Council shall make such recommendations as are considered necessary, if invited to do so by the Government.”
