

THE BURMA GENERAL CLAUSES (AMENDMENT) ACT, 1951.

[Act No. XLIV of 1951.]

It is hereby enacted as follows :—

1. This Act may be called the Burma General Clauses (Amendment) Act, 1951.

2. In section 2 of the Burma General Clauses Act, *after* clause (42), the following *shall be inserted as* clause (42A), namely :—

“(42A) ‘office of profit’ shall not be deemed to include an office which is a part-time office remunerated by travelling allowance or daily allowance only or both.”
